General information

We would like to draw the attention of students to strict adherence to the deadlines. Applications submitted after the deadline will be rejected, unless the student submits it together with a request for equity (**the student may make a request for equity once during his or her studies**). Please send your applications electronically to the tanulmanyi@tpfk.hu e-mail address, and the original must be handed in in person at the Registrar's Office in Budapest or sent by post to the Registrar's Office in Budapest. In case of postal mail, please always send your request **by registered mail and with acknowledgement of receipt**. You can find information about the opening hours and contact details of the Registrar's Office on the website.

The student must attach to the application all documents (certificates, certificates, permits, findings) **that are necessary for the assessment of the application**. The student will be informed about any correction of deficiencies via e-mail or phone, so it is important to check the correctness of their data recorded in NEPTUN and their e-mail inbox.

Even in the case of a request for equity, all documents that may be the basis for the claim for equity (e.g. medical certificate, employer's certificate) must be attached.

Please check your data recorded in NEPTUN regularly! The bank account number recorded in NEPTUN is especially important, because the College can only make repayments to a valid bank account. The College does not take responsibility for any inconvenience caused by an incorrectly entered bank account number.

For those whose social security is valid on the basis of their student status, it is extremely important **to accurately record their social security number in NEPTUN**, as they will not be insured without it.
